

The Calais School, Teacher position announcement

The Calais School is a state-approved provider of special education for students with special needs. The school serves students in grades Pre-K through 12 Plus with multiple learning disabilities.

Due to increasing enrollment, we have a need for a Special Education Teacher for grades 6/7.

Responsibilities include:

- The Teacher shall effectively utilize tablet technology and educational applications for the 21st century classroom.
- The Teacher shall be responsible for the incorporation and implementation of each student's I.E.P. and shall be fully responsible for all lesson plans, material selection, monthly anecdotal and progress reports as designated in the protocol of the school.
- The Teacher shall be responsible for maintenance of the classroom materials (software and hardware) as well as classroom bulletin boards and those hall bulletin boards as assigned.
- The Teacher shall be directly responsible for the behavior modification program and the maintenance of tokens for each student seen during the class day.
- The Teacher will work closely with the assigned LDTC and therapist in developing behavioral and academic programs.
- The Teacher shall participate in all required professional meetings held both during and after the school day.
- The Teacher shall be responsible for the direct supervision and safety of all students assigned to his/her classroom.
- The Teacher shall supervise in the halls prior to the beginning of class, during class change, at lunchtime and after school, when required.
- In addition to those duties which are designated as a Teacher of Students with Disabilities, or Teacher of the Handicapped, the Teacher may also be required to act as a specialist in a given subject area, e.g. math, social studies, science, etc.
- The Teacher shall supervise the Assistant Teacher assigned to him/her and will delegate duties for each period of the school day.

Qualifications:

- Candidates must possess a dual certification-- Teacher of the Handicapped OR Teacher of Students with Disabilities AND Elementary Teacher Certification K-8.
- Experience teaching special education students is a must.
- Must have the patience and passion to work with Special Education students.
