### TEACHER OF STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Special education teachers design, adapt and teach programs geared to each student's Individual Education Plan (IEP.) Teachers work as part of an interdisciplinary team with The Phoenix Center's behaviorists, social workers, counselors, employment specialists, occupational, physical and speech/language therapists. Responsible for educational planning and implementing lessons based on student's IEP's. Lessons should be developmentally appropriate, age-appropriate and must align with CCCS (Core Curriculum Content Standards). Assist in the supervising, instructing, working with, and evaluating their instructional paraprofessionals, and any student teachers assigned to them, as directed by their supervisor.

### Requirements

- Bachelor's degree from accredited college or university with special education emphasis.
- NJ Teacher of the Handicapped Certificate or Teacher of Students with Disabilities Certificate, K-5 Elementary or Middle School Certificate
- Experience with individuals with autism and multiple disabilities a plus.
